PASTOR'S ARTICLE

HEAVEN IS A PLACE FREE FROM CORRUPTION

This present world we live in is filled with corruption from which it is groaning to be delivered (Rom. 8:21-22). This is seen in every area of God's creation. There are natural disasters such as earthquakes, hurricanes, tornados, floods and volcanic eruptions. In the animal world this is seen in the ferociousness of the wild beasts. The thorn in the rose is another example of this curse-laden creation. But the number one evidence of a corrupted creation is mankind who suffers from sin, sickness and diseases of all kinds.

In Romans 8:18-25 Paul talks about a future deliverance from the painful things that cause us to groan and suffer in this life. In verse 18 he introduces this passage by saying, "For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us [in Heaven]." What a powerful thought! The suffering we go through in this life will be like a drop of water in the ocean, compared to the glory that will be revealed in us when we get to Heaven. Heaven is a place where glory will be revealed in us. This glory includes deliverance from sin, sorrows, sickness, persecution, suffering and disasters.

In another place Paul expanded on this Romans' passage when he wrote, "For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory" (2 Cor. 4:17). This one verse is packed with three powerful truths about "glory" or Heaven. First, our afflictions on this earth are bearable in light of Heaven's perfect environment and the glorious bodies we will receive there. Second, the afflictions on this earth are temporary; the weight of glory is eternal. Third, the suffering "light afflictions" on this earth add to the fulfillment of our Heavenly experience.
