DAVID'S DECLARATION

David declared he would watch his actions and guard (muzzle) his speech in the presence of the wicked. Evidently there was something that bothered him while he was in their presence (1). He subdued his words and actions even to the point of not saying anything good (2).

DAVID'S INDIGNATION

His voluntary silence only caused him to become more angry and outraged. The in a fit of frustration he launches into a heated tirade (3).

DAVID'S HUMILIATION

He Asks for Wisdom Concerning Life.

After his sin, David prays to the Lord to help him know the brevity of life (4-5) and the vanity of life (6).

He Says He Will Hope in the Lord.

It seems that David started out intending to hope (trust) in the Lord but he got off track. Now as he is refocused, he says that he will wait for the Lord and hope in Him (7).

He Asks for Deliverance from Transgressions.

David then asks the Lord to free him from his transgressions and deliver him from their consequences (8).

He Will Be Silent Before God.

It seems at this point David is under the chastening hand of God. His silence in verse 2 was in regards to his disdain for the wicked, his silence here is about the discipline of the Father (9).

He Acknowledged His Humility.

David was beat down from God's chastening hand and he pleads with Him to remove it from his life (10). The result of God's discipline can reduce a person to nothing (11).

DAVID'S SUPPLICATION

David prays for the Lord to hear his prayer, see his tears and show him the same mercy He would show a stranger and pilgrim (12). He also asks the Lord to turn His gaze (God's angry countenance) away from him before he is utterly consumed (13).
