Atheism—there is no God

IN THE BEGINNING GOD

God Is Eternal (Ps. 90:1-2)

He eternally existed before the creation of all things.

God Is Self-Sufficient (Ps. 50:12)

He has never nor will ever depend on anything outside of Himself to exist.

God Is All-Powerful (Jer. 32:27)

He has absolute power which extends over all of His creation.

God Is the Architect and Designer (Heb. 3:4)
Nothing existed before He designed and built it.
